Retired <i>(permanently from work)</i>	£2.17	£26.04

- The part-time rate has been revised in line with a CHCC NPC decision.
- Retired members are defined as those who are retired from chaplaincy in a paid, honorary or voluntary capacity and who are in receipt of a pension. The category is for those who are not actively engaged in chaplaincy in any way, since they are retired, but who wish to maintain a contact and interest in the world of health care chaplaincy.
- There have been changes in the methods of payment of the political fund and members should note that the political levy is included in all the subscription rates shown above. Should members wish to opt-out of the fund, they may obtain further information from the CHCC Registrar.
- Associate members are those with an interest in chaplaincy, but who are not engaged in direct services, either paid or voluntary. Further details may be obtained by contacting the Registrar.
