Introductory Training for Newly Appointed Healthcare Chaplains

In partnership with the UK Departments of Health, AHPCC, CHCC, NIHCA and SACH the UKBHC commissioned the development of an on-line introductory training course for newly appointed healthcare chaplains. The course is now available for enrolment and is suitable for all newly appointed healthcare chaplains, voluntary chaplains and chaplaincy volunteers.

New chaplains can self-enrol on the course and all work is completed on-line. In agreement with their line manager chaplains can choose the pace they wish to work at. The course can be completed in a 2-3 day block or over a number of weeks/months.

The course has been accredited by the UKBHC for Continuing Professional Development with 15 CPD points.
